## **Second Tower Crane Arrives**



The second of the two tower cranes is being assembled and steel installation is set to continue. As was the case with the first tower crane, the arrival of the second crane was delayed due to revisions of the Department of Buildings (DOB) tower crane protocols. The logistics on Sixth Street will continue to be implemented and will likely be extended as needed to accommodate this phase of the project.

Work to install the building's Con Edison vaults on Fifth Street continues, and a section of the sidewalk remains closed. The progress of vault construction continues to be impacted by weather. It is now expected to be complete by the end of January.

Due to the delay, vault construction and Fifth Street utility work may need to occur simultaneously during the end of January and beginning of February. Notification will be provided in the event that this is necessary. As with the site utility work performed in June and July, this work will impact traffic and parking intermittently.

Following the completion of the Con Edison vaults, the schedule for Sixth Street sewer work and the revocable consent trench for connection to the existing building will be determined. This activity will be coordinated with steel installation, and we will distribute notification when the work is scheduled to occur.

## **Upcoming Work**

The current construction work hours are Monday through Friday, from 7:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m.

When there is a need to make up for delays due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances, work is done between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Saturdays. Separate notifications for weekend work will be distributed when necessary with the description of work activities.

- Steel installation to continue
- Temporary barricades at Con Edison vaults to be removed
- Fifth Street utility work to commence

#### February 11<sup>th</sup> – February 17<sup>th</sup>

- Steel installation to continue
- Fifth Street utility work to continue
