Internationally renowned breast surgeon and researcher, **Lisa A. Newman, MD, MPH**, has been appointed Chief, Section of Breast Surgery and Chief of the Interdisciplinary Breast Program at NewYork-Presbyterian/Weill Cornell Medical Center. Dr. Newman leads a multispecialty team that offers:

- advanced screening and imaging technologies
- innovative surgical and reconstruction techniques, including nipple- and skin-sparing mastectomies
- novel radiation approaches, including intraoperative radiation therapy
