Recycling Facts

- Recycling 2,000 lbs. of paper saves the equivalent of 17 trees.
- Recycling one aluminum can saves enough energy to run a television, or operate a computer for three hours.

Blood and Blood Products:

Discarded bulk human blood and blood products in free draining, liquid state; body fluids contaminated with visible blood; and materials saturated/dripping with blood defined as:

- 50% or more covered with blood/fluid, or
- Could drip blood if it was squeezed.

Blood and Blood Products shall not include feminine hygiene products.



Recycling

Recycling involves processing used materials waste into new products to prevent waste of potentially useful materials.

Collecting all plastics, metals, paper and glass at Nursing Stations, Staff Lounges, and Administrative Areas.
