NYPCHP Now Pays for Vaccine Administration

New York Presbyterian Community Health Plan (NYPCHP) is pleased announce the following changes in reporting patient visits and provider billing for 2007. These changes are in response to NYPCHP's vision of working collaboratively with our providers to provide the highest quality health care services to our members.

Below are the a summary of the changes that are effective July 1, 2007

1. NYPCHP will now reimburse providers for administration of vaccines for adults and children.

Yes, Providers will now be reimbursed a **\$10 administrative fee** for each vaccine based on the CPT codes 90471 and 90472.

To ensure administrative fee payment submit encounters (billable and non-billable) on a HCFA 1500 form and mail it to:

If you bill electronically, submit your encounters using Payor Code: 48186.

2. NYPCHP re-emphasizes the use of specific CPT and ICD-9 CM Codes used to identify Well-Child Visits

In order to qualify for your annual **\$20 well-visit incentive** and be credited for the well visits during the QARR review, the following codes need to be used when submitting your HCFA 1500 forms for the well child visit:

CPT Codes	ICD-9-CM Codes
99381, 99382, 99392, 99432	V20.2, V70.0, V70.3, V70.5, V70.6, V70.8, V70.9
