Program Description:

NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital is a 2400+ bed tertiary care facility consisting of two primary centers affiliated with the medical colleges of Columbia and Cornell Universities. This is the third year for PGY-2 specialty residency programs at NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital. One position in Critical Care will be offered for practitioners who desire to advance their knowledge and skills in critical care pharmacotherapy upon successful completion of a PGY-1 residency. The program is flexible and focuses on the goals of the resident but is intended to provide clinical, research, and teaching experience. Competitive salary and benefits are provided. Application for ASHP accreditation submitted.
