Program Description:

NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital is a 2400+ bed tertiary care facility consisting of two primary centers affiliated with the medical colleges of Columbia and Cornell Universities. This is the fourth year for PGY-2 specialty residency programs at NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital and one position in Infectious Diseases will be offered for practitioners who desire to advance their knowledge and skills in infectious diseases pharmacotherapy. The program is flexible and focuses on the goals of the resident but is intended to provide clinical, research, and teaching experience. Competitive salary and benefits are provided. The program is ASHP-accredited.
