Did you know there is a simple, convenient way to obtain and store your medical information online and become actively involved in managing your health?

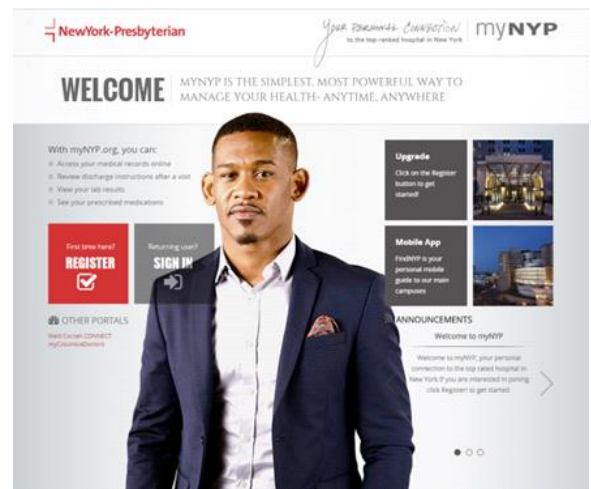
Sign up for myNYP.org a free, security-enhanced, web-based, interactive personal health record. The website is available in English and Spanish; however the medical information is only in English.

Have access to your medication history, surgery reports, hospital discharge instructions, laboratory test results, radiology reports, immunization history, allergy information, doctor and insurance information, and emergency contacts.

Getting started is simple follow these three easy steps:

1. Create an account
2. Agree to Terms and Conditions
3. Match yourself:
 - a. Via EMPI/Verification Code
 - b. Self-enroll by correctly answering the identifying questions
 - c. Via Patient Invitation Email

What is not included

The Doctor’s office visit; radiology images, colonoscopy reports, endoscopy reports, infusion information, PET scans, and HIV, STD/STIs, pathology and cultures test results.
