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USMLE/COMLEX Step III

- 1. In order to be eligible to receive a contract for the PGY II year, residents must provide evidence of registering to take USMLE/COMLEX Step III prior to March 1st of the PGY I year. Residents who have not provided evidence of registering for the examination, and are otherwise in good standing, will be issued a letter stating that a decision to recontract cannot be made at the time and will be given a maximum of three months to register for the exam. Failure to comply will result in termination from the program at the conclusion of the PGY I year.
- 2. In order to be eligible to receive a contract for the PGY III year, residents must provide evidence of a passing score on USMLE/COMLEX Step III prior to December 31st of the PGY II year. Residents, who have not provided evidence of a passing grade and are otherwise in good standing, will be issued a letter stating that a decision to re-contract cannot be made at the time and will be given a maximum of three months to provide evidence of passing the examination. Failure to comply will result in termination from the program at the conclusion of the PGY II year.
- 3. Residents terminated due to not taking or not passing the USMLE/COMLEX III, in the specified time period, may reapply to their program upon receipt of a passing score. Acceptance is not guaranteed.
- 4. This policy is applicable to residents seeking to transfer to an NYP/Q sponsored program and to all fellows entering.
- 5. Monitoring and compliance is expected at the program level.
- 6. Exemptions to this policy, for good cause or hardship circumstances, may be requested by the Program Director to the Designated Institutional Official and/or the Graduate Medical Education Committee.
