

POLICY: 1.005 FACT-GP

As part of the enrollment process, CMAs may complete a FACT-GP with each HH eligible patient at the time of enrollment, annually, and at disenrollment. The FACT-GP does not replace a comprehensive assessment.

What is a FACT-GP?

The Fact-GP is an optional basic functional assessment of patients' overall wellbeing (physical, social/family, emotional, functional). The Department of Health uses this basic information to measure longitudinal changes in patients and determine risk scores for billing purposes.

PROCEDURES:

FACT-GP

1. CMAs may complete a FACT-GP for each consented patient at the time of enrollment, annually while the patient remains actively enrolled, and at disenrollment from the HH program.
2. The Fact-GP must be completed in the appropriate language based on patient preferences. The form is currently available in these languages:

English	Chinese (Traditional and Simplified)	Haitian Creole
French	Italian	Korean
Russian	Spanish	

Note: Simplified Chinese is commonly used by patients from China, Malaysia, or Singapore, while Traditional Chinese is commonly used by patients from Hong Kong, Taiwan

1. CMAs complete optional FACT-GP Assessment on ACD for each patient enrolled in the Health Home program.
