GNVHA and the Continuing Care Leadership Coalition (CCLC) are hosting additional cultural competency training sessions for frontline staff in 2016. The interactive training sessions provide frontline staff an opportunity to learn and practice cultural competency skills that will be beneficial in their daily work caring for patients. Staff participation can also assist member facilities to meet Delivery System Reform Incentive Payment program cultural competency training expectations.

These training sessions were designed with the support of the New York State

Department of Health under its Health Workforce Retraining Initiative. GNYHA and CCLC encourage hospitals and continuing care facilities to send multidisciplinary teams to the training sessions, including registration and admitting staff, case managers, nurses, community health workers, patient navigators, dietitians, physical and occupational therapists, transporters, pastoral care staff, social workers, and others who interact with patients. In addition, frontline health workers of community-based partners of Performing Provider Systems (PPS) are also invited to attend.

Each full-day session offers the same curriculum and focuses on addressing race, ethnicity, religion, language, disability, sexual and gender identity, and end-of-life care in a health care setting. Continuing education units are available for nursing and social workers.

PPSs that plan to invite staff from community-based partner organizations are asked to designate a PPS contact to work with GNYHA to coordinate the registration of staff from these non-GNYHA member organizations.
