- Behavioral health; and/or
- 3. Appropriate ED use.

Who has applied for funding?


12 organizations submitted 14 RFPs (not only CBOs).

Next steps: RFP Review Workgroup

- January: 5 person team meeting regularly, 2 non-NYP, 3 NYP staff;
- February (into March, if needed): Finalists invited to make in-person presentations. Select 3-5 awardees and announce to PPS. Review Workgroup disbanded;
- March (into April, if needed): PPS PMO works with awardees to develop project plans/milestones. Contracting terms and invoicing processes established;
- April: Interventions launch.

2018 CBO Impact Fund Proposal Types Showcase Diverse Service Offerings in the PPS & Equally Diverse Service Needs amongst Patients






CBO Impact Fund Successfully Sourced RFPs Matching Geographies of Patient Needs to CBO Catchment/Service Areas

8 Proposals (57%) Submitted for BH Care Coordination


 Hot-spots (zip code of residence) for patients in need of mental health outpatient care following an inpatient discharge (with a behavioral health diagnosis):
