Value Based Payment Training Webinar Series

The NYP PPS and NYP/Queens PPS have come together to co-sponsor a series of webinars on VBP 101 and the New York State Value-Based Payment (VBP) Roadmap. Separate sessions for the three provider types, as outlined by NYS, are being offered: Behavioral Health (BH), CBOs and Primary Care providers.
